

La zona de salón se ha equipado con un sillón antiguo con tonalidades en beige y un sofá negro de IKEA con cojines vibrantes y la firma Textura.





Al tratarse de un último piso, pudieron derribar los falsos techos y buscar la luz que les faltaba.

Una planta en la que contaban con un comedor, cocina, dormitorio y baño, es ahora un espacio confortable de altos techos.

Materiales nobles como la madera y el metal son los elementos arquitectónicos principales. De líneas simples y minimalistas, contrastan a la perfección con el mobiliario antiguo.

La decoración está llena de recuerdos: de familia o de viajes, como el mobiliario del comedor, creación de un tío abuelo del propietario, o la colección de cuadros antiguos que la pareja ha dispuesto sobre el aparador. Aquí y allá, todos los objetos decorativos hablan de recuerdos de familia y de sus viajes.







En la zona de la cocina se buscó un estilo sencillo y en blanco total, interrumpido por las cristalerías con perfiles de acero para la zona de almacenaje, y que aprovecha el hue-

co existente bajo la escalera. El pavimento de este espacio, realizado en mosaico hidráulico en tonos verdes, rompe la continuidad de la madera del resto de la vivienda.








Una habitación casi en su totalidad en tonos verdesos y muebles de herencia.
